Illustrating Taxpayers constant requests for Fiduciary Responsibility

Abstract:

Complaint originally filed Nov. 30, 2015 as part of fifteen citizen complaints filed against Whatcom County Officials alleging election law violations related to printing and mailing the Whatcom County Jail Report mailer using taxpayers funds to promote the .2% jail sales tax illegally and unfairly while promoting the expansion of a regional jail project, violating civil rights, and more. Addendums 1-2-3 further show documents that illustrate to this citizen how these same officials over decades have worked in tandem with jail industry insiders to subvert the intent of law, misused taxpayers facilities, funds and resources, violated taxpayers rights to due process leading up to the campaign, have demonstrated conflicts of interest using jail industry vendors, and violated trust, fiduciary responsibilities and oaths of office during the multi-year planning process, and have been operating the jail in violation of Whatcom County Code 1.28.100 and other State and Federal laws.
